#### Board of Directors Meeting, Executive team Summary-May 1, 2025

#### **Medical Director Report:**

- The medical providers had a chart audit to look at our coding. We have all started to
  make some of the suggested changes and will meet with Kelly Maldonado, our
  medical biller, to discuss other improvements and ways to make our coding practices
  more efficient.
- We will be starting another round of chart reviews in the next month, focusing on hypertension management

### **Operations Director Report:**

- Staffing: We've onboarded 2 dentists, a Registered Nurse (RN) and our Human Resources coordinator.
- The form 990 is still pending due to the solar rebate paperwork.
- Front desk continues to track the same-day discount and how many people are using it or leaving it on the table. We continue to do small tests of change with the data we are seeing from the phone regarding abandoned calls. We have not started working with a Dr. Catalyst staff member yet but are getting the process going.
- Patient satisfaction surveys went out last week and we are getting a lot of responses thanks to NexHealth. Within the first 24 hours we had 70 responses. This saves the front desk a lot of work.
- We are working with the billing team to get to a monthly hard close process. Right now, the billing team is working on closing past years.

#### **Executive Director Report:**

- There were a lot of advocacy efforts this month. We met with Congressman Huffman to address FQHC concerns regarding federal grant cuts and/or Medicaid cuts. I also spoke with a journalist from SacBee about the rural perspective and will share her article when it's published. I wrote a letter to the editor for the Mendocino Voice. There is also another bill (AB1113) that has been crafted by SEIU and introduced in the CA health committee. It would require all FQHCs to commit to using 90% of their funds for "mission driven" services. The definition they have come up with for "mission driven" leaves out a lot of things required to run a business (administration, rent/mortgage, property taxes, insurance costs etc). We've sent letters of opposition.
- The impact of the Targeted Rate Increase (TRI) on CHRN is still unknown. Waiting to have a meeting with CHRN and Partnership lawyers.
- Billing chart audits will be reviewed by providers with Kelly present to discuss how to
  optimize the EMR for some coding issues. Kelly and Jason will meet with the providers
  to work on the clinical rules engine build which is related to coding standardization.
- The Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) re-score data was submitted for the dental re-score.
- Our next Operational Site Visit with HRSA will be Oct-Dec 2025. We are on schedule for policy review and the next big item will be the needs assessment, which the Write Choice Network will complete. The risk Management Report will be presented tonight.
- The employee satisfaction survey has gone out with changes this year.
